Parkside Federation Academies runs two secondary schools in Cambridge, Coleridge Community College and Parkside Community College. We also operate an international Sixth Form, Parkside Sixth.

What is the City of Cambridge Education Foundation and what does it do?

The City of Cambridge Education Foundation is a charitable company limited by guarantee. The Foundation guides on the direction, focus and ethos of all schools within the Federation for all current and future generations. The Foundation is committed to improving life chances for all students.

The charitable objects are to advance the education of students of Parkside Federation Academies, Ridgefield Primary School and the community resident within the City of Cambridge, both young people and adults, maintaining commitment at all times to:-

- meeting the educational needs and aspirations of the pupils of the Federation;
- addressing the educational needs and aspirations and promoting cohesion in the community resident within the City of Cambridge;

- equality of access and opportunity for all;
- excellence in teaching and learning; and
- active collaboration with educational and other partners

How the Trust Works?

The Trust has a Board who oversees the running of the Trust; they meet regularly and are supported by the work of the Company Secretary. The Board consists of the Executive Principal of Parkside Federation Academies, local and district councillors, a representative of the partner primary schools, the Chair to the Governors and other governors as well as business and community representatives.

How Can I have my say?

By applying to become a member of the Trust.

All adult users of the Trust's facilities for example, all parents/carers of students who attend any of the Federation schools and members of staff are eligible to become members of the Trust. This entitles them to receive updates on the activities of the Foundation and attend the Annual General Meeting of the Trust as well as elect Board Members.
